Alternate Energy Solutions, Inc. to continue training on a utility-scale wind turbine installations in Colorado.

Company representatives plan to continue project construction shadowing with an international turbine manufacturer during the month of January. Alternate Energy Solutions' staff will monitor and assist with utility-scale wind turbine tower assembly, rotor and generator assembly. Our primary objective this month is to experience, first-hand, site staging issues associate with wind turbine assembly. Working side-by-side with the manufacturer will provide for valuable insight as the company prepares for possible future turbine installations. The assembly and commissioning of wind turbine generation projects is expected to commence January 21, 2008, in Colorado, as part of a private letter Memorandum of Understanding between the company and the manufacturer.

The particular wind turbine developments mentioned here are not company projects; but rather, a training task for Alternate Energy Solutions, as we progress with the manufacturer toward achieving factory certification. Each wind turbine assembly is expected to take approximately three to four days. Additional time is required for internal wiring, system function testing, inspection by electrical authorities having jurisdiction, and final commissioning.
