Alternate Energy Solutions, Inc. travels to mainland China to investigate wind farm development and joint-venture wind turbine manufacturing opportunities.

Alternate Energy Solutions, Inc. would like to state that the company recently completed a twelve day visit to mainland China. The purpose of the trip was to learn more about the renewable energy in the People's Republic of China (PRC) and government policies toward business joint-ventures and wind farm development. The company also explored opportunities for the co-manufacturing of medium- and large-scale wind turbine components between U.S. and Chinese firms. Under PRC law, 70% of the wind turbine components must be manufactured in China, the law also permits an allowance for up to 30% of wind turbine components to be imported.

Representing the company on the trip was Melvin Bredemeier, John Wolar, and an invited colleague. While in China, the company's delegation traveled to Beijing, the western regions of China and southern provinces. The delegation met with executives from several major electric utilities, federal, provincial and local government representatives, engineers from the China Department of Energy and manufacturing entities interested in Sino-American partnerships to expand their operations to meet an aggressive government policy mandating 30,000MW of new wind turbine installation nameplate power within the next fifteen years.

Alternate Energy Solutions has entered into a representation agreement, with a well-known international Chinese consultant, to further explore possible joint-venture opportunities in the PRC. Several excellent opportunities for wind farm development and manufacturing have been identified.
